ALA is a postgraduate international and interdisciplinary 2-yrs (120ECT) Erasmus Joint Master Programme in Architecture, Landscape and Archaeology, developed by a consortium of 4 institutions (University of Rome Sapienza, University of Coimbra, National Technical University of Athens, University of Naples Federico II) and associated partners (other universities, governmental and international agencies, museums and archaeological sites, architectural professional offices).

The three partner countries, Italy, Greece, Portugal, represent academic and professional excellence in the fields of architecture, landscape and archaeology at European and global level. Nowadays architects and archaeologists are different professions whose training and education follow diverse paths, regardless the frequent and increasing need for a joint and shared approach especially in the professional challenges (national boards for heritage, conservation companies, architects' offices, etc.).

The ALA Master has therefore the following finalities:

- a fully recognized Joint Degree;
- to encourage interaction between the different professions and a better integration between preservation strategies, planning and contemporary design interventions;
- to form highly specialized experts able to understand and apply the correct analytical, scientific and creative skills for the enhancement of archaeological contexts;
- to bridge academic and job-market needs with the exchange of expertise in a highly innovative research area (Archaeology/Cultural Heritage/Design/Public-Private investments).

Themes: The field trip will be articulated into in several visits, guided by experts, to the archaeological sites of Pompeii, Herculaneum, Pozzuoli, Baia, Cuma, Miseno. In this way, students will be introduced to specific realities, in order to have the opportunity to grasp important aspects of archaeological and enhancement activities. The study trip, based on the support of the local Superintendency, will provide a direct contact with the archaeological sites.

Methods and Tools: Lessons; Case studies; Site visits.

Final Exam: elaboration of drawings and models aimed at summarizing the fieldwork and definition of first group project proposals.



Aims: to consolidate the theoretical contents acquired through the lessons and site inspections. The Design Workshop will focus on the topic of the survey and the enhancement of the archaeological landscape of Pompeii.

Themes: The module will focus on the relations of the archaeological site with the external areas (to the north the agricultural landscape, to the south public spaces, to the west infrastructures, to the east the urban environment); the internal relations within the archaeological city (excavations in progress, preservation activities and landscape restoration; improvement of accessibility). The workshop activities will be interdisciplinary and will include a dialogue with the specialists of the Archaeological Superintendence of Pompeii and Herculaneum.

Methods and Tools: Study Seminar; Case studies; Laboratory.

Final Exam: elaboration and discussion of group projects with jury and proclamation of the winning project.
