EVALUATION RULES

The Consortium Committee has given the right attention to all the valid applications since it is interest of the master to recruit the best students.

All applications have been evaluated as follows:

Education up to 20 pts

Graduate, postgraduate and extra courses

Work up to 20 pts

Length and quality of the professional practice

Award & Publications up to 20 pts

Only publications with ISBN or ISSN and disciplinary awards

Portfolio or thesis up to 20 pts

For portfolio: capacity and quality of architectural and landscape design, presence of heritage comprehension, attention to site specificity; for thesis: pertinence to the topics of the ALA master

Motivation & Interview up to 30 pts

Ability to motivate the need for transdisciplinary collaboration between the subjects covered in the master's course; knowledge of contemporary issues concerning architecture, landscape, archaeology; ability to have a conscious and possibly original and innovative point of view

Particular attention has been given to those applications that had past experience regarding the relationship between architecture and archaeology, especially if with an attention to design issues.

Furthermore, it is important to specify that the evaluation is comparative among the applicants for each intake, so grades and rankings are given in a relative and proportional way.

Please note that special care was taken to avoid any discrimination. Applications were considered solely on the basis of their academic merits, abilities and potential, regardless of gender, ethnic or national origin, age, disability, religion, sexual orientation or any other distinction.

Since the scholarships we offer are 12/20 per year the competition is very high.

Appeal can be accepted only with proved evidence of supposed errors. It needs to be presented with a letter by a lawyer.

Two separate lists (for Architects and Archaeologists) of admitted students were made. Students ranking between 50-64 are eligible as self paying students or as other scholarships holders.
