Design Studio A: Archaeology within the urban tissue

Module leader:

Nelly Marda

Aims: to practice aspects of contemporary interventions in archaeological sites in relation to the urban tissue of Athens historic area; to use mappings in creating new strategies of intervention in archaeological sites.

Themes: work on a studio project located on the archaeological site of Olympieion and its surroundings; lectures about digital/analytical, sensorial mappings, map recordings; in situ exercises; program formulation; lectures on design methodology, landscape design in comparison to architectural composition; weekly workshop introducing the application of digital tools to the site.

Methods and Tools: illustrated lectures, tutorials, site visits, workshops, group work, project presentations, the use of e-learning platform for project feedback and discussion.

Final Assessment: Digital submission and oral project presentation – concept in the form of text, drawings and models- in front of a jury of invited scholars.

The module takes place every Monday and Thursday (15.00 - 18.00) On selected Wednesdays D. Charitos will offer a series of lectures on applications of augmented and virtual reality in architecture and archaeology.

2.d Module Analysis and Interpretation: historical and methodological issues

Module leader: Manolis Mikrakis

Aims: to provide theoretical knowledge and practical skills for analysing and interpreting urban archaeological sites; to familiarize students with the archaeology of Athens

Themes: general introduction to archaeological research and the topography of monuments in Athens; digital documentation methods; the organization of public, domestic, religious and funerary space; site visits to the Akropolis, the Ancient Agora, the Roman Agora and other sites; recent fieldwork triggered by the unification of the archaeological sites of Athens, the development of facilities for the Athens 2004 Olympic Games or the construction of the metropolitan subway.

Methods and Tools: illustrated lectures, site visits, group discussion, e-learning.

Final Assessment: Submission and oral presentations of an essay (3000 words).

Themes: critical issues of cultural heritage; the city as a palimpsest and as a locus of liminal areas; hermeneutical interpretations and architectural interventions; theory on interventions within historical sites; exemplary cases from the international scene and the Greek domain.

Final Assessment: Submission and oral presentations of an essay (3000 words).
